

Sales Tax Rules and Regulations – Resale Certificate

In compliance with Sales and Use Tax Laws it is necessary that we have a signed resale certificate on file from all of our customers, with State Sales Tax Permit and Number, to show that merchandise has been purchased for resale. In addition, we ask that you provide us with a copy of your resale certificate.

The good faith of the seller will be questioned if he/she has knowledge of the facts, which give rise to a reasonable inference that purchaser does not intend to re-sell the property as, for example: Knowledge that purchaser of particular merchandise is not in the business of selling that kind of merchandise.

Under the “Description of property purchased” may appear:

- (1) Either an itemized list of the particular property to be purchased for resale, or
- (2) A general description of the kind of property to be purchased for resale.

Such certificate is good until revoked in writing.
